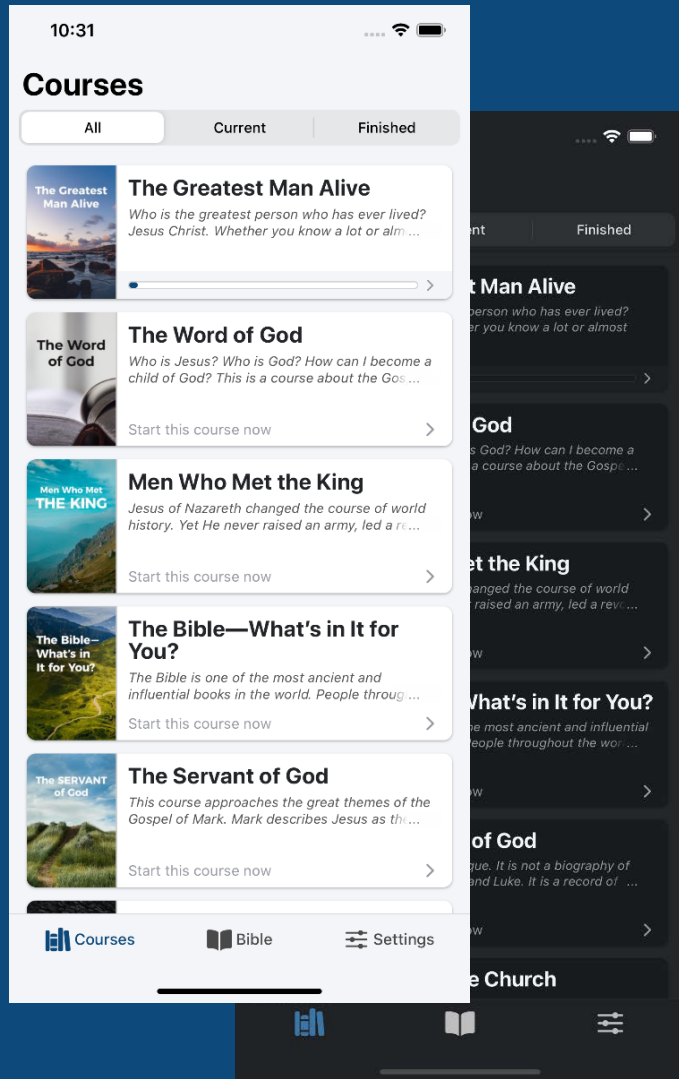

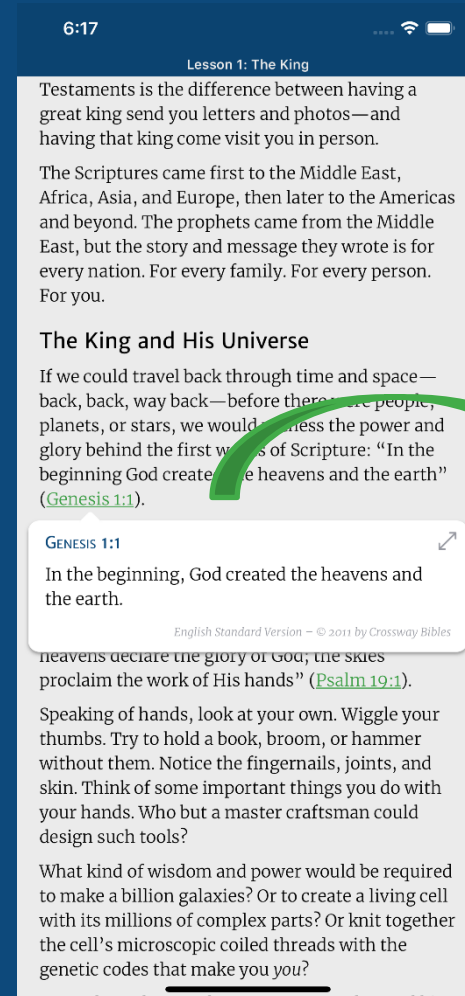

back. He raced back to the shop and exchanged his hard-earned savings for his battered boat. As he retraced his steps home, he whispered to the boat carefully cradled in his arms, “You are mine twice over now, little boat: first, because I made you, and second, because I redeemed you.”

That simple story pictures what God has done for us. Mankind is “twice-owned” by God. First, we rightfully belong to Him because He created us. But we became separated from Him because of sin (that is, all the wrong things we do, say, or even think, that are offensive to a holy and sinless God). Like the little sailboat, we were helpless—helpless to free ourselves from sin’s power. God’s Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, willingly paid the price for our sin when He was crucified. From the first book of the Bible (Genesis) to the last book (Revelation), God reveals His plan to redeem, or buy back, humankind and to create a wonderful kingdom for those who choose to believe in Him and be freed (saved) from sin’s penalty and power.

Many people who revere the Bible believe the greatest statement in it is found in the book of [John, chapter 3, verse 16](#). Maybe you have seen this verse displayed on a poster or banner held high by Christians. It is the good news (gospel) of

JOHN 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

That is good news. The verse tells us that God loves all mankind. That includes you. Furthermore, He proved His love for you by giving His Son for you. By “giving” we mean that when Jesus died on the cross, He was dying for you. He took the punishment for your sins. When a person places his complete trust in the fact that Jesus died for his or her own personal sins, God promises to save that person from eternal punishment for sin. And instead of being punished, that person will experience joyful everlasting life with God in His eternal kingdom. What a marvelous salvation!

God’s offer of salvation to individuals makes the Bible personal. But the good news of salvation isn’t the only thing that’s in the Bible for you. There’s plenty more, as you will discover as you read on in this course.

The Bible Is Priceless

Abraham Lincoln, the sixteenth president of the United States, commented that the Bible “is the best gift God has ever given to man. All the good from the Savior of the world is communicated to us through this book; but for this book, we could not know right from wrong. All things desirable to man are contained in the Bible.”

16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. **17** For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. **18** Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. **19** And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. **20** For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. **21** But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God.”

John the Baptist Exalts Christ

22 After this Jesus and his disciples went into the Judean countryside, and he remained there with them and was baptizing. **23** John also was baptizing at Aenon near Salim, because water was plentiful there, and people were coming and being baptized **24** (for John had not yet been put in prison).

25 Now a discussion arose between some of John’s disciples and a Jew over purification. **26** And they came to John and said to him, “Rabbi, he who was with you across the Jordan, to whom you bore witness — look, he is baptizing, and all are going to him.” **27** John answered, “A person cannot receive even one thing unless it is given him from heaven. **28** You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, ‘I am not the Christ, but I have been sent before him.’ **29** The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom’s voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete. **30** He must increase, but I must decrease.”

31 He who comes from above is above all. He who is of the earth belongs to the earth and speaks in an earthly way. He who comes from heaven is above all. **32** He bears witness to what he has seen and heard, yet no one receives his testimony. **33** Whoever receives his testimony sets his seal to this, that God is true. **34** For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for he gives the Spirit without measure. **35** The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand. **36** Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

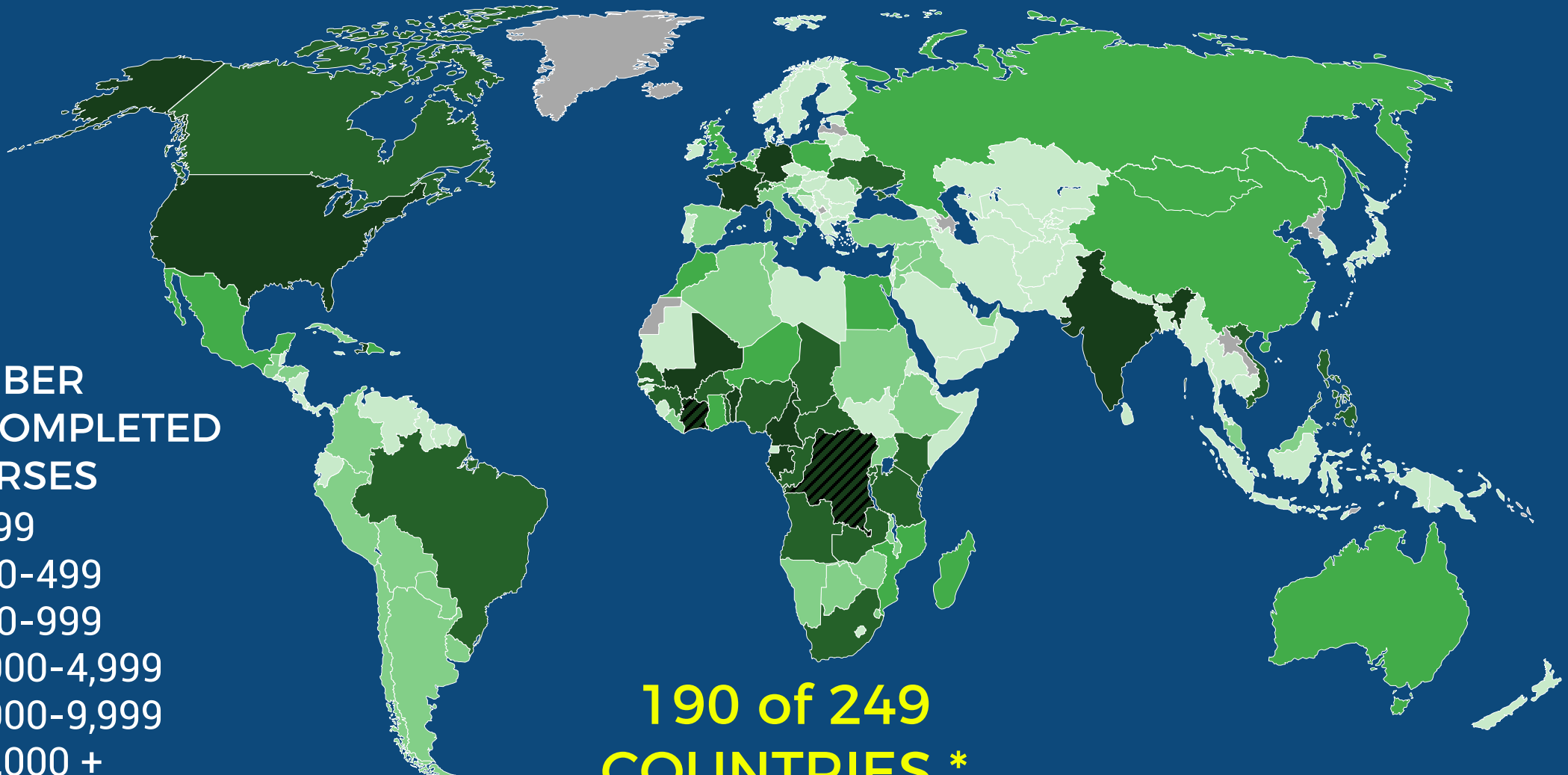

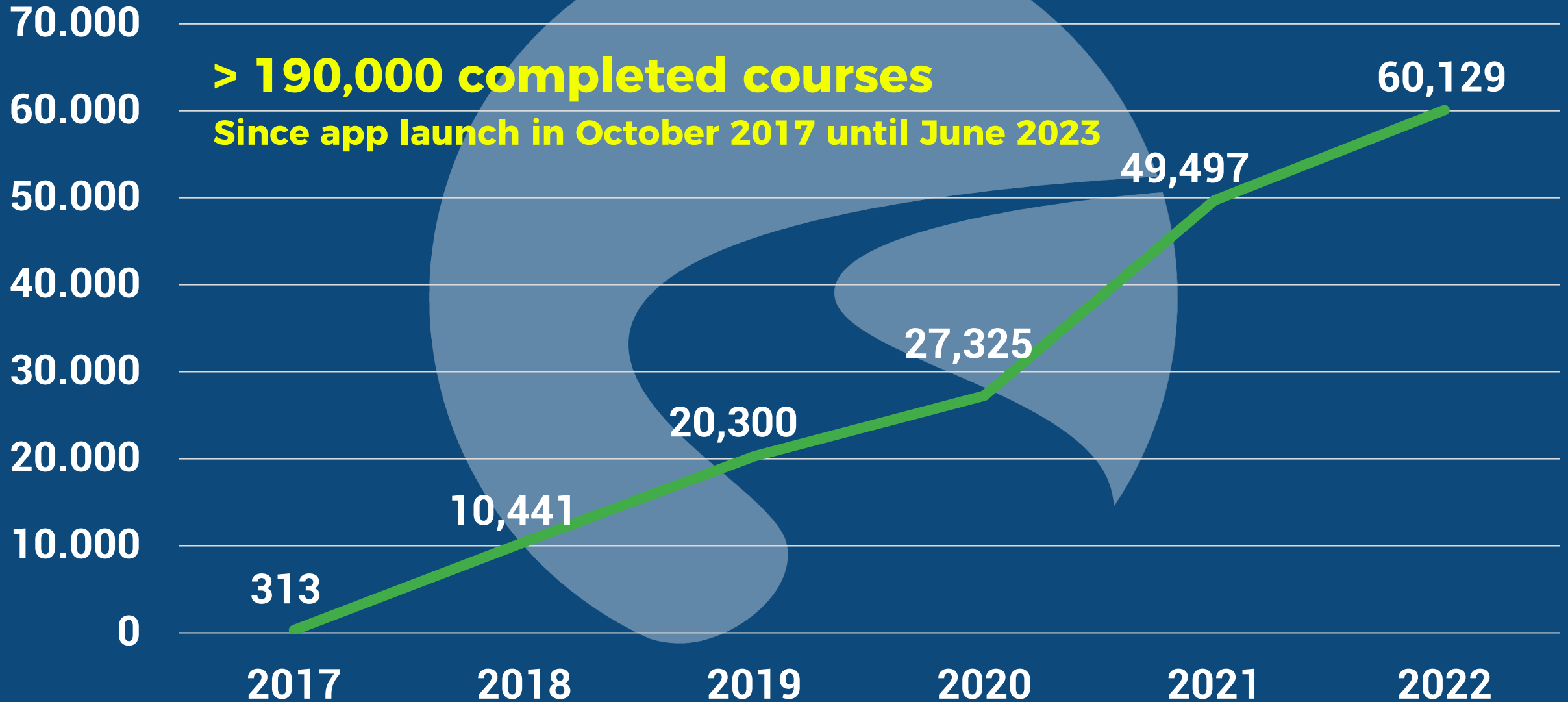

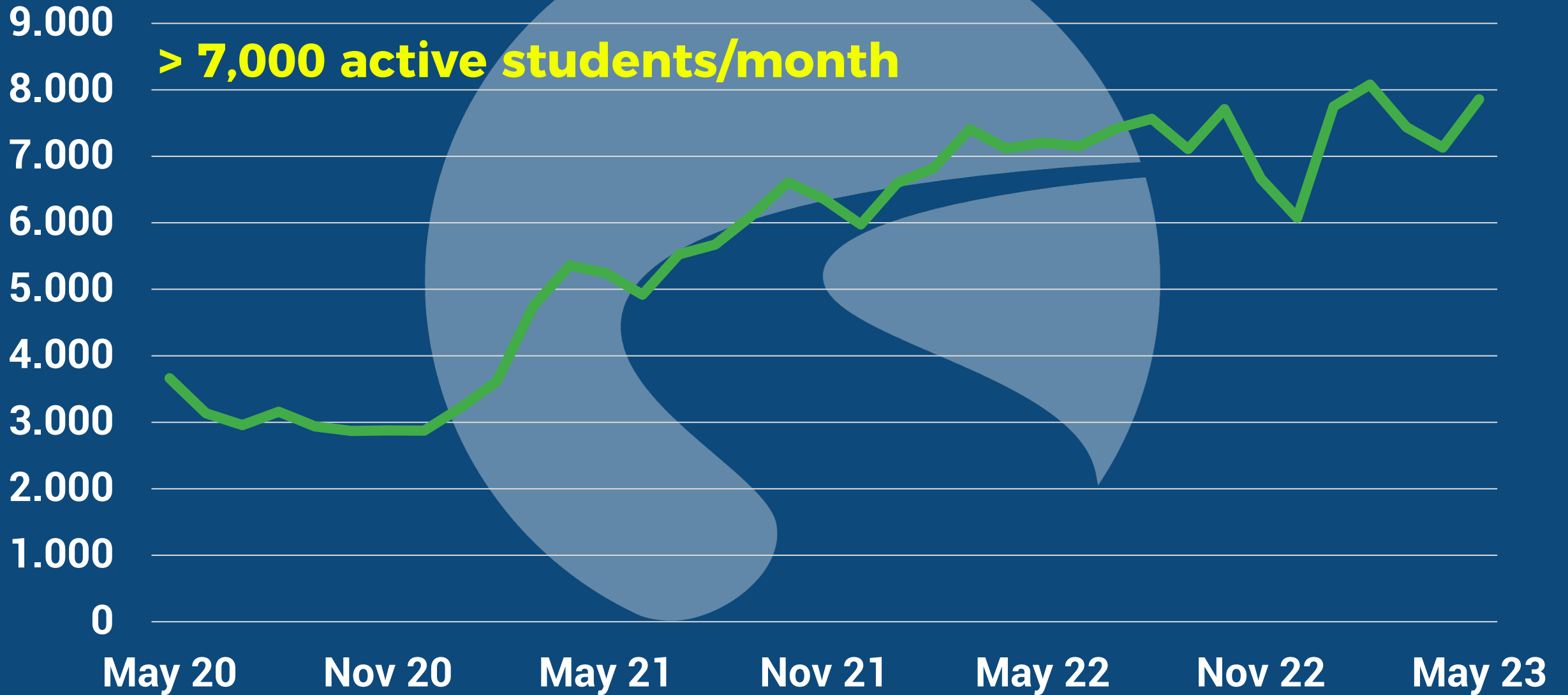
